

**Cage specifications as per ordinance 8 of 1969 [Ord on Nature Conservation
Free State].**

- (1) No person may keep a wild animal in captivity unless the animal is kept in a camp or sturdy enclosure of the following minimum surface area or capacity:
- (a) 0,5 hectare for every elephant, hippopotamus, giraffe, rhinoceros, zebra or buck bigger than an impala –
: Provided that no camp or enclosure may be smaller than 1 hectare;
 - (b) 0,25 hectare for every impala or buck smaller than an impala –
: Provided that no camp or enclosure may be smaller than 0,5 hectare;
 - (c) 0,5 hectare for every lion, cheetah, brown hyaena or spotted Hyaena –
: Provided that no camp or enclosure may be smaller than 1 hectare;
 - (d) 200 square metres for a leopard if there are no more than two and an additional 100 square metres for each leopard exceeding two.
 - (e) 10 square metres for every other predator of the order Carnivora –
: Provided that no camp or enclosure may be smaller than 100 square metres;
 - (f) 30 cubic metres for a monkey or baboon if there are no more than two and an additional 3 cubic metres for every monkey or baboon exceeding two.
 - (g) 1 square metre for every other small mammal –
: Provided that no camp or enclosure may be smaller than 20 square metres;
 - (h) 0,25 cubic metres for every bird smaller than a duck, which is not of a predatory species –
: Provided that the cage may not be smaller than 8 cubic metres;
 - (i) 30 cubic metres for every bird of a predatory species –
: Provided that
 - (j) the cage may not be smaller than 60 cubic metres;

(ii) every side of the cage must be of such a size that it covers at least twice the wingspan of the bird with the biggest wingspan in the cage;

(k) 10 square metres for every bird which is as big as or bigger than a duck –

: Provided that no cage may be smaller than 50 square metres and that, in case such a bird can fly, the height of the cage must be such that it covers at least three times the wingspan of the bird with the biggest wingspan in the cage;

(l) 1 square metre for every snake, pythons excluded –

: Provided that no cage may be smaller than 2 square metres;

(m) 10 square metres for every python or crocodile –

: Provided that no cage may be smaller than 20 square metres;

(n) 1 square metre for any other reptile or amphibian –

: Provided that no cage may be smaller than 2 square metres.
